

Early Childhood Studies

(Montessori)

INTRODUCTION

This course is designed for those who wish to work with children under the age of 6 years and is especially geared towards Montessori. It is both a nationally and internationally recognised qualification and students who have successfully graduated are now working, worldwide, in the sector. This qualification is the minimum requirement for those wishing to work in the area. Students get the opportunity to have hands-on experience and acquire the theory to support it. Students participate in

- Childcare seminars and conferences
- Practical workshops in Siolta and Aistear
- Child Protection training
- Professional Guest Lectures
- Educational field trips

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Leaving Certificate. Mature students are exempt from Leaving Certificate requirement. All applicants are interviewed and Garda vetted. Police clearance is required for non-Irish nationals. English, Irish and Maths are required subjects. *(Applicants with 2 H5 grades on higher level Leaving Certificate papers and required results from QQI level 6 6M2007 are guaranteed a place in year 3 (CR_HMONT_8) Level 8 BA Montessori Education CIT).*

CERTIFICATION

QQI Level 5 Certificate in Early Childhood Care & Education 5M2009. Manual handling training and certification (requirement for work experience). QQI Component Maths 5N1833 (available as option in evening for learners requiring Maths for progression).

WORK PLACEMENT/EXPERIENCE

Students will undertake placement two mornings per week for the duration of the course for a minimum of 120 hours in a registered Montessori setting. Garda vetting is an integral part of the application procedure for this course.

EDUCATION PROGRESSION OPPORTUNITIES

CCOC QQI Level 6 Advanced Certificate In Early Childhood Education 6M2007. Excellent progression opportunities to UCC and other Higher Education colleges. Special arrangements in place with CIT (CCPS), Tralee IT and Waterford IT for preferential entry for College of Commerce students. Up to 390 CAO points for any Institute of Technology can be attained by successful completion of this course.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Students are qualified as Assistant Early Childhood Practitioners in pre-schools and crèches, Special Needs Assistants and can work as a Child Minder in the home.
