

Advanced Health Services Supervisory Management Skills

INTRODUCTION

This course offers holders of a QQI Level 5 Health related award (e.g. Level 5 HCA or Nursing Studies) the opportunity to undertake further studies in the area. This award will equip the learner with the necessary knowledge, skills and competence to undertake supervisory roles in the caring environment. Students participate in

- Professional guest lectures
- Organising college Health Promotion week
- MAPA (Management of Actual or Potential Aggression) Training
- Workshops and conferences
- Holistics workshop
- *Pitstop* Leadership Programme from Common Purpose for selected students.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

For entry to Level 6 a full QQI Level 5 Award in a complementary area is required.

CERTIFICATION

QQI Level 6 Advanced Certificate in Health Services Supervisory Management Skills 6M4978. Manual handling and people moving training and certification (requirement for work experience). QQI Component Maths 5N1833 (available as option in evening for learners needing Maths for progression). Vulnerable Adult Awareness Certificate. MAPA (Management of Actual or Potential Aggression). Certificate in Adult CPR.

WORK PLACEMENT/EXPERIENCE

Students will undertake work placement one day per week in a variety of healthcare settings for the duration of the course. Garda vetting is an integral part of the application procedure for this course. Vaccinations are required for work experience in a healthcare setting.

EDUCATION PROGRESSION OPPORTUNITIES

Excellent progression opportunities to UCC and other Higher Education colleges. Special arrangements in place with CIT (CCPS), Tralee IT and Waterford IT for preferential entry for College of Commerce students. Up to 390 CAO points for any Institute of Technology can be attained by successful completion of this course..
